4th Sunday Advent Readings: Lighting the Angels' Candle Joshua, Kay Cee, Hazel & Peter Ling

Pastor: The fourth purple candle reminds us of the angels as they prepared people for the coming Christ-Child.

2nd Reader: The angel Gabriel told a virgin named Mary the wonderful news of the birth of the Messiah. "You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give Him the name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David, and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever; His kingdom will never end." Luke 1:31-33
