

Closing Hymn: *In Christ Alone*

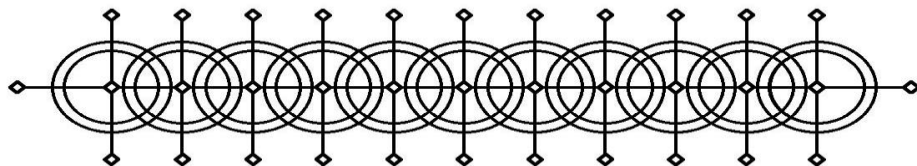
In Christ alone my hope is found
