calling of meetings. A new sound system for the sanctuary is soon to go live. Our new playground was completed. A special thanks to the men who worked to complete this project, and to Zack Hartman for donating a Bobcat. We have need of a new compressor for the Sanctuary AC system and the expense was approved. Session is grateful for the work of our deacons on the building and grounds, especially Randy Moore for his work on the lawn, air filters and our AC units. Our deacons have a church wide work day scheduled for July 11. Many hands accomplish great things! Our budget is about \$5,000 behind for the year. We have 3 staggered CD’s totaling about \$70,000 as our Large Capital Improvement Fund. Our next meeting is August 18 at 6pm.
