**Confession of Faith: Heidelberg Catechism, Q. 60**

**Q. 60:** How are you righteous before God now that you believe all this?

**A. : Only by true faith in Jesus Christ: That is, although my conscience accuses me that I have grievously sinned against all God's commandments and never kept any of them, and that I still am always inclined to all evil, nevertheless God, without any merit of mine, out of sheer grace, grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner, as if I had been perfectly obedient as Christ was obedient for me, if only I accept this gift with a believing heart. AMEN.**
